# **Course Options:**

**Fairy Gardens:** Use your imagination to create your own fairy garden. Fill your world with fairy houses and more! We'll use a combination of natural and recycled materials and students will have a chance to sow a real plant.

Class Limit: 8 Grades: K-3 Instructor: Mrs. Morrissette

**Cooking:** Students will learn basic baking and cooking techniques each week as we taste our way through six different recipes using the Primrose kitchen. Bon appetit!

Class Limit: 10 Grades: K-3 Instructor: Ms. Salvo

**Guided Painting:** Students will use a variety of different paints each week to create a unique masterpiece with Ms. White. Students will be guided through drawing and painting the topic of the week but will be able to use their creativity where they see fit. The last painting will be a final work done on canvas.

Class Limit: 12 Grades: 1-3 Instructor: Mrs. White

**Knitting:** Knitting is a creative and meditative craft for all ages. In this introductory course, children will learn basic skills and create small projects to build confidence. We begin with finger knitting, then progress to casting on and the knit stitch. The health benefits of knitting are far reaching... Get your child hooked on this life-long skill!

**Dance:** Mrs. Melo will be leading a six week course which will focus on dance! Mrs. Melo has been dancing for 23 years and has been teaching for 10. This class will teach students about two forms of dance, ballet and jazz. No experience is required to take this class and children in grade k-3 are welcome! Lessons will include, mental focus, strength, flexibility, and the importance of practice. Throughout the six weeks, students will learn the positions of ballet, stretch techniques, and a warm up routine. Students will also learn a short dance to be performed at the end of the course. Participants must wear or bring comfortable clothes.

**Coding:** Want to learn how to be the boss of a computer? During this beginning coding course, students will discover how to make characters move, jump, dance and sing. Students with experience will learn how to code their own game! Over six weeks students will begin to use a programming language created by MIT called Scratch. Scratch helps kids explore the foundations of block programming as they develop their flexibility, perseverance, and coding skills.

**Beginning Robotics:** How cool would it be to program your own robot? This class will explore a few simple robots including Spheros and mBots. We will use coding and navigating skills to complete fun robot challenges.

**Adventures in Art:** Young artists will develop their creative abilities through drawing and painting exploration. This class is open to all students who love art and want to improve their artistic skills. We will experiment with different techniques and materials and each artist will create several masterpieces to bring home and display. Mrs. August has been teaching elementary school for nearly 30 years and always looks for opportunities to incorporate her love of art into the classroom. Join us and we will create together!
